Epic Salon Spa	• \$86,318.00 – 05/24/2024 • “Epic Salon Spa, LLC” • Funds are to open a new full service salon in Riverton. This project will create eight new jobs including recent graduates of Central Wyoming College. The salon spa will offer custom wig ordering, and fitting for oncology patients.
Java Java	• \$48,000.00 • “Java Java Espresso – North Federal” • Funding to assist with the expansion of business providing for equipment at a second location. Money is specific to purchasing kitchen equipment.
